

## Lesson 1 – God’s Unlikely Choice – 1 Sam 9, 10, 16, 17

### **1 Samuel 9,10**

#### **1 Samuel 3:20**

<sup>20</sup> And all Israel from Dan even to Beersheba knew that Samuel *was* established *to be* a prophet of the LORD.

#### **1 Samuel 10:6**

<sup>6</sup> And the Spirit of the LORD will come upon thee, and thou shalt prophesy with them, and shalt be turned into another man.

#### **1 Samuel 10:9**

<sup>9</sup> And it was *so*, that when he had turned his back to go from Samuel, God gave him another heart: and all those signs came to pass that day.

### **1 Samuel 16,17**

#### **2 Chronicles 16:9**

<sup>9</sup> For the eyes of the LORD run to and fro throughout the whole earth, to shew himself strong in the behalf of *them* whose heart *is* perfect toward him. Herein thou hast done foolishly: therefore from henceforth thou shalt have wars.

## Lesson 2 – God’s Giant Killer -1 Sam 17

### **1 Samuel 17**

#### **1 Samuel 17:11**

<sup>11</sup> When Saul and all Israel heard those words of the Philistine, they were dismayed, and greatly afraid.

#### **1 Samuel 17:24**

<sup>24</sup> And all the men of Israel, when they saw the man, fled from him, and were sore afraid.

#### **1 Samuel 6:14**

<sup>14</sup> And the cart came into the field of Joshua, a Bethshemite, and stood there, where *there was* a great stone: and they clave the wood of the cart, and offered the kine a burnt offering unto the LORD.

#### **1 Samuel 17:28**

<sup>28</sup> And Eliab his eldest brother heard when he spake unto the men; and Eliab's anger was kindled against David, and he said, Why camest thou down hither? and with whom hast thou left those few sheep in the wilderness? I know thy pride, and the naughtiness of thine heart; for thou art come down that thou mightest see the battle.

### **Numbers 12**

#### **John 7:3-10**

<sup>3</sup> His brethren therefore said unto him, Depart hence, and go into Judaea, that thy disciples also may see the works that thou doest.

<sup>4</sup> For *there is* no man *that* doeth any thing in secret, and he himself seeketh to be known openly. If thou do these things, shew thyself to the world.

<sup>5</sup> For neither did his brethren believe in him.

<sup>6</sup> Then Jesus said unto them, My time is not yet come: but your time is always ready.

<sup>7</sup> The world cannot hate you; but me it hateth, because I testify of it, that the works thereof are evil.

<sup>8</sup> Go ye up unto this feast: I go not up yet unto this feast; for my time is not yet full come.

<sup>9</sup> When he had said these words unto them, he abode *still* in Galilee.

<sup>10</sup> But when his brethren were gone up, then went he also up unto the feast, not openly, but as it were in secret.

#### **1 Samuel 17:33**

<sup>33</sup> And Saul said to David, Thou art not able to go against this Philistine to fight with him: for thou *art but* a youth, and he a man of war from his youth.

### **1 Samuel 17:36**

<sup>36</sup> Thy servant slew both the lion and the bear: and this uncircumcised Philistine shall be as one of them, seeing he hath defied the armies of the living God.

### **1 Samuel 17:26**

<sup>26</sup> And David spake to the men that stood by him, saying, What shall be done to the man that killeth this Philistine, and taketh away the reproach from Israel? for who *is* this uncircumcised Philistine, that he should defy the armies of the living God?

### **1 Samuel 17:45-46**

<sup>45</sup> Then said David to the Philistine, Thou comest to me with a sword, and with a spear, and with a shield: but I come to thee in the name of the LORD of hosts, the God of the armies of Israel, whom thou hast defied.

<sup>46</sup> This day will the LORD deliver thee into mine hand; and I will smite thee, and take thine head from thee; and I will give the carcasses of the host of the Philistines this day unto the fowls of the air, and to the wild beasts of the earth; that all the earth may know that there is a God in Israel.

### **1 Samuel 17:47**

<sup>47</sup> And all this assembly shall know that the LORD saveth not with sword and spear: for the battle *is* the LORD'S, and he will give you into our hands.

### **1 Samuel 17:26**

<sup>26</sup> And David spake to the men that stood by him, saying, What shall be done to the man that killeth this Philistine, and taketh away the reproach from Israel? for who *is* this uncircumcised Philistine, that he should defy the armies of the living God?

### **1 Samuel 17:16**

<sup>16</sup> And the Philistine drew near morning and evening, and presented himself forty days.

### **1 Samuel 17:48**

<sup>48</sup> And it came to pass, when the Philistine arose, and came and drew nigh to meet David, that David hasted, and ran toward the army to meet the Philistine.

### **1 Samuel 17:40**

<sup>40</sup> And he took his staff in his hand, and chose him five smooth stones out of the brook, and put them in a shepherd's bag which he had, even in a scrip; and his sling *was* in his hand: and he drew near to the Philistine.

**Acts 13:22**

<sup>22</sup> And when he had removed him, he raised up unto them David to be their king; to whom also he gave testimony, and said, I have found David the *son* of Jesse, a man after mine own heart, which shall fulfil all my will.

### Lesson 3 – God’s Model of Being a Good Enemy - 1 Sam 18

#### **1 Samuel 9:15-21**

<sup>15</sup> Now the LORD had told Samuel in his ear a day before Saul came, saying,

<sup>16</sup> To morrow about this time I will send thee a man out of the land of Benjamin, and thou shalt anoint him *to be* captain over my people Israel, that he may save my people out of the hand of the Philistines: for I have looked upon my people, because their cry is come unto me.

<sup>17</sup> And when Samuel saw Saul, the LORD said unto him, Behold the man whom I spake to thee of! this same shall reign over my people.

<sup>18</sup> Then Saul drew near to Samuel in the gate, and said, Tell me, I pray thee, where the seer's house *is*.

<sup>19</sup> And Samuel answered Saul, and said, I *am* the seer: go up before me unto the high place; for ye shall eat with me to day, and to morrow I will let thee go, and will tell thee all that *is* in thine heart.

<sup>20</sup> And as for thine asses that were lost three days ago, set not thy mind on them; for they are found. And on whom *is* all the desire of Israel? *Is it* not on thee, and on all thy father's house?

<sup>21</sup> And Saul answered and said, *Am* not I a Benjamite, of the smallest of the tribes of Israel? and my family the least of all the families of the tribe of Benjamin? wherefore then speakest thou so to me?

#### **1 Samuel 10:21-24**

<sup>21</sup> When he had caused the tribe of Benjamin to come near by their families, the family of Matri was taken, and Saul the son of Kish was taken: and when they sought him, he could not be found.

<sup>22</sup> Therefore they enquired of the LORD further, if the man should yet come thither. And the LORD answered, Behold, he hath hid himself among the stuff.

<sup>23</sup> And they ran and fetched him thence: and when he stood among the people, he was higher than any of the people from his shoulders and upward.

<sup>24</sup> And Samuel said to all the people, See ye him whom the LORD hath chosen, that *there is* none like him among all the people? And all the people shouted, and said, God save the king.

### **1 Samuel 15:17-23**

<sup>17</sup> And Samuel said, When thou *wast* little in thine own sight, *wast* thou not *made* the head of the tribes of Israel, and the LORD anointed thee king over Israel?

<sup>18</sup> And the LORD sent thee on a journey, and said, Go and utterly destroy the sinners the Amalekites, and fight against them until they be consumed.

<sup>19</sup> Wherefore then didst thou not obey the voice of the LORD, but didst fly upon the spoil, and didst evil in the sight of the LORD?

<sup>20</sup> And Saul said unto Samuel, Yea, I have obeyed the voice of the LORD, and have gone the way which the LORD sent me, and have brought Agag the king of Amalek, and have utterly destroyed the Amalekites.

<sup>21</sup> But the people took of the spoil, sheep and oxen, the chief of the things which should have been utterly destroyed, to sacrifice unto the LORD thy God in Gilgal.

<sup>22</sup> And Samuel said, Hath the LORD *as great* delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices, as in obeying the voice of the LORD? Behold, to obey *is* better than sacrifice, *and* to hearken than the fat of rams.

<sup>23</sup> For rebellion *is as* the sin of witchcraft, and stubbornness *is as* iniquity and idolatry. Because thou hast rejected the word of the LORD, he hath also rejected thee from *being* king.

### **1 Samuel 15:24-26**

<sup>24</sup> And Saul said unto Samuel, I have sinned: for I have transgressed the commandment of the LORD, and thy words: because I feared the people, and obeyed their voice.

<sup>25</sup> Now therefore, I pray thee, pardon my sin, and turn again with me, that I may worship the LORD.

<sup>26</sup> And Samuel said unto Saul, I will not return with thee: for thou hast rejected the word of the LORD, and the LORD hath rejected thee from being king over Israel.

### **2 Samuel 12:13**

<sup>13</sup> And David said unto Nathan, I have sinned against the LORD. And Nathan said unto David, The LORD also hath put away thy sin; thou shalt not die.

### **1 Samuel 13:14**

<sup>14</sup> But now thy kingdom shall not continue: the LORD hath sought him a man after his own heart, and the LORD hath commanded him *to be* captain over his people, because thou hast not kept *that* which the LORD commanded thee.

### **1 Samuel 10:22-24**

<sup>22</sup> Therefore they enquired of the LORD further, if the man should yet come thither. And the LORD answered, Behold, he hath hid himself among the stuff.

<sup>23</sup> And they ran and fetched him thence: and when he stood among the people, he was higher than any of the people from his shoulders and upward.

<sup>24</sup> And Samuel said to all the people, See ye him whom the LORD hath chosen, that *there is* none like him among all the people? And all the people shouted, and said, God save the king.



### **1 Samuel 16:6-13**

<sup>6</sup> And it came to pass, when they were come, that he looked on Eliab, and said, Surely the LORD'S anointed *is* before him.

<sup>7</sup> But the LORD said unto Samuel, Look not on his countenance, or on the height of his stature; because I have refused him: for *the LORD seeth* not as man seeth; for man looketh on the outward appearance, but the LORD looketh on the heart.

<sup>8</sup> Then Jesse called Abinadab, and made him pass before Samuel. And he said, Neither hath the LORD chosen this.

<sup>9</sup> Then Jesse made Shammah to pass by. And he said, Neither hath the LORD chosen this.

<sup>10</sup> Again, Jesse made seven of his sons to pass before Samuel. And Samuel said unto Jesse, The LORD hath not chosen these.

<sup>11</sup> And Samuel said unto Jesse, Are here all *thy* children? And he said, There remaineth yet the youngest, and, behold, he keepeth the sheep. And Samuel said unto Jesse, Send and fetch him: for we will not sit down till he come hither.

<sup>12</sup> And he sent, and brought him in. Now he *was* ruddy, *and* withal of a beautiful countenance, and goodly to look to. And the LORD said, Arise, anoint him: for this *is* he.

<sup>13</sup> Then Samuel took the horn of oil, and anointed him in the midst of his brethren: and the Spirit of the LORD came upon David from that day forward. So Samuel rose up, and went to Ramah.

### **1 Samuel 18:6-16**

#### **1 Samuel 18:28-30**

<sup>28</sup> And Saul saw and knew that the LORD *was* with David, and *that* Michal Saul's daughter loved him.

<sup>29</sup> And Saul was yet the more afraid of David; and Saul became David's enemy continually.

<sup>30</sup> Then the princes of the Philistines went forth: and it came to pass, after they went forth, *that* David behaved himself more wisely than all the servants of Saul; so that his name was much set by.

#### **1 Samuel 18:12**

<sup>12</sup> And Saul was afraid of David, because the LORD was with him, and was departed from Saul.

#### **1 Samuel 18:28-29**

<sup>28</sup> And Saul saw and knew that the LORD *was* with David, and *that* Michal Saul's daughter loved him.

<sup>29</sup> And Saul was yet the more afraid of David; and Saul became David's enemy continually.

### **1 Samuel 24:3-21**

### **1 Samuel 26:8-25**

## **2 Corinthians 7:9-11**

<sup>9</sup> Now I rejoice, not that ye were made sorry, but that ye sorrowed to repentance: for ye were made sorry after a godly manner, that ye might receive damage by us in nothing.

<sup>10</sup> For godly sorrow worketh repentance to salvation not to be repented of: but the sorrow of the world worketh death.

<sup>11</sup> For behold this selfsame thing, that ye sorrowed after a godly sort, what carefulness it wrought in you, yea, *what* clearing of yourselves, yea, *what* indignation, yea, *what* fear, yea, *what* vehement desire, yea, *what* zeal, yea, *what* revenge! In all *things* ye have approved yourselves to be clear in this matter.

## Lesson 4 – God’s Mediator – 1 Sam 25

### 1 Samuel 25

#### 1 Samuel 25:2-3

<sup>2</sup> And *there was* a man in Maon, whose possessions *were* in Carmel; and the man *was* very great, and he had three thousand sheep, and a thousand goats: and he was shearing his sheep in Carmel.

<sup>3</sup> Now the name of the man *was* Nabal; and the name of his wife Abigail: and *she was* a woman of good understanding, and of a beautiful countenance: but the man *was* churlish and evil in his doings; and he *was* of the house of Caleb.

#### 1 Samuel 25:11

<sup>11</sup> Shall I then take my bread, and my water, and my flesh that I have killed for my shearers, and give *it* unto men, whom I know not whence they *be*?

#### 1 Samuel 25:17

<sup>17</sup> Now therefore know and consider what thou wilt do; for evil is determined against our master, and against all his household: for he *is such* a son of Belial, that *a man* cannot speak to him.

#### 1 Samuel 25:25

<sup>25</sup> Let not my lord, I pray thee, regard this man of Belial, *even* Nabal: for as his name *is*, so *is* he; Nabal *is* his name, and folly *is* with him: but I thine handmaid saw not the young men of my lord, whom thou didst send.

#### 1 Samuel 25:36

<sup>36</sup> And Abigail came to Nabal; and, behold, he held a feast in his house, like the feast of a king; and Nabal's heart *was* merry within him, for he *was* very drunken: wherefore she told him nothing, less or more, until the morning light.

#### 1 Samuel 25:3

<sup>3</sup> Now the name of the man *was* Nabal; and the name of his wife Abigail: and *she was* a woman of good understanding, and of a beautiful countenance: but the man *was* churlish and evil in his doings; and he *was* of the house of Caleb.

#### 1 Samuel 25:18

<sup>18</sup> Then Abigail made haste, and took two hundred loaves, and two bottles of wine, and five sheep ready dressed, and five measures of parched *corn*, and an hundred clusters of raisins, and two hundred cakes of figs, and laid *them* on asses.

**1 Samuel 25:24**

<sup>24</sup> And fell at his feet, and said, Upon me, my lord, *upon me let this iniquity be*: and let thine handmaid, I pray thee, speak in thine audience, and hear the words of thine handmaid.

**1 Samuel 25:33**

<sup>33</sup> And blessed *be* thy advice, and blessed *be* thou, which hast kept me this day from coming to *shed* blood, and from avenging myself with mine own hand.

**1 Timothy 2:5-6**

<sup>5</sup> For *there is* one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus;

<sup>6</sup> Who gave himself a ransom for all, to be testified in due time.

**1 Samuel 25:25**

<sup>25</sup> Let not my lord, I pray thee, regard this man of Belial, *even* Nabal: for as his name *is*, so *is* he; Nabal *is* his name, and folly *is* with him: but I thine handmaid saw not the young men of my lord, whom thou didst send.

<sup>16</sup> *Be* of the same mind one toward another. Mind not high things, but condescend to men of low estate. Be not wise in your own conceits.

<sup>17</sup> Recompense to no man evil for evil. Provide things honest in the sight of all men.

<sup>18</sup> If it be possible, as much as lieth in you, live peaceably with all men.

<sup>19</sup> Dearly beloved, avenge not yourselves, but *rather* give place unto wrath: for it is written, Vengeance *is* mine; I will repay, saith the Lord.

<sup>20</sup> Therefore if thine enemy hunger, feed him; if he thirst, give him drink: for in so doing thou shalt heap coals of fire on his head.

<sup>21</sup> Be not overcome of evil, but overcome evil with good.

**Psalm 141:5**

<sup>5</sup> Let the righteous smite me; *it shall be* a kindness: and let him reprove me; *it shall be* an excellent oil, *which* shall not break my head: for yet my prayer also *shall be* in their calamities.

**Proverbs 23:31-32**

<sup>31</sup> Look not thou upon the wine when it is red, when it giveth his colour in the cup, *when* it moveth itself aright.

<sup>32</sup> At the last it biteth like a serpent, and stingeth like an adder.

## Lesson 5 – God’s Carnal Man – 1 Sam 27

### **1 Samuel 27**

#### **1 Samuel 27:1**

<sup>1</sup> And David said in his heart, I shall now perish one day by the hand of Saul: *there is* nothing better for me than that I should speedily escape into the land of the Philistines; and Saul shall despair of me, to seek me any more in any coast of Israel: so shall I escape out of his hand.

#### **1 Samuel 23:2**

<sup>2</sup> Therefore David enquired of the LORD, saying, Shall I go and smite these Philistines? And the LORD said unto David, Go, and smite the Philistines, and save Keilah.

#### **1 Samuel 23:4**

<sup>4</sup> Then David enquired of the LORD yet again. And the LORD answered him and said, Arise, go down to Keilah; for I will deliver the Philistines into thine hand.

#### **1 Samuel 30:8**

<sup>8</sup> And David enquired at the LORD, saying, Shall I pursue after this troop? shall I overtake them? And he answered him, Pursue: for thou shalt surely overtake *them*, and without fail recover *all*.

### **2 Samuel 2:1**

<sup>1</sup> And it came to pass after this, that David enquired of the LORD, saying, Shall I go up into any of the cities of Judah? And the LORD said unto him, Go up. And David said, Whither shall I go up? And he said, Unto Hebron.

### **2 Samuel 5:19**

<sup>19</sup> And David enquired of the LORD, saying, Shall I go up to the Philistines? wilt thou deliver them into mine hand? And the LORD said unto David, Go up: for I will doubtless deliver the Philistines into thine hand.

### **2 Samuel 5:23**

<sup>23</sup> And when David enquired of the LORD, he said, Thou shalt not go up; *but* fetch a compass behind them, and come upon them over against the mulberry trees.

### **1 Samuel 16:13**

<sup>13</sup> Then Samuel took the horn of oil, and anointed him in the midst of his brethren: and the Spirit of the LORD came upon David from that day forward. So Samuel rose up, and went to Ramah.

### **1 Samuel 23:17**

<sup>17</sup> And he said unto him, Fear not: for the hand of Saul my father shall not find thee; and thou shalt be king over Israel, and I shall be next unto thee; and that also Saul my father knoweth.

### **1 Samuel 24:20**

<sup>20</sup> And now, behold, I know well that thou shalt surely be king, and that the kingdom of Israel shall be established in thine hand.

### **1 Samuel 25:30**

<sup>30</sup> And it shall come to pass, when the LORD shall have done to my lord according to all the good that he hath spoken concerning thee, and shall have appointed thee ruler over Israel;

### **1 Corinthians 2:14-3:3**

<sup>14</sup> But the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know *them*, because they are spiritually discerned.

<sup>15</sup> But he that is spiritual judgeth all things, yet he himself is judged of no man.

<sup>16</sup> For who hath known the mind of the Lord, that he may instruct him? But we have the mind of Christ.

<sup>1</sup> And I, brethren, could not speak unto you as unto spiritual, but as unto carnal, *even* as unto babes in Christ.

<sup>2</sup> I have fed you with milk, and not with meat: for hitherto ye were not able *to bear it*, neither yet now are ye able.

<sup>3</sup> For ye are yet carnal: for whereas *there is* among you envying, and strife, and divisions, are ye not carnal, and walk as men?

<sup>10</sup> For Demas hath forsaken me, having loved this present world, and is departed unto Thessalonica; Crescens to Galatia, Titus unto Dalmatia.

### **1 Samuel 27:4**

<sup>4</sup> And it was told Saul that David was fled to Gath: and he sought no more again for him.

### **1 Samuel 27:7**

<sup>7</sup> And the time that David dwelt in the country of the Philistines was a full year and four months.

### **1 Samuel 27:8-12**

<sup>8</sup> And David and his men went up, and invaded the Geshurites, and the Gezrites, and the Amalekites: for those *nations were* of old the inhabitants of the land, as thou goest to Shur, even unto the land of Egypt.

<sup>9</sup> And David smote the land, and left neither man nor woman alive, and took away the sheep, and the oxen, and the asses, and the camels, and the apparel, and returned, and came to Achish.

<sup>10</sup> And Achish said, Whither have ye made a road to day? And David said, Against the south of Judah, and against the south of the Jerahmeelites, and against the south of the Kenites.

<sup>11</sup> And David saved neither man nor woman alive, to bring *tidings* to Gath, saying, Lest they should tell on us, saying, So did David, and so *will be* his manner all the while he dwelleth in the country of the Philistines.

<sup>12</sup> And Achish believed David, saying, He hath made his people Israel utterly to abhor him; therefore he shall be my servant for ever.

### **1 Samuel 30:1-6**

<sup>1</sup> And it came to pass, when David and his men were come to Ziklag on the third day, that the Amalekites had invaded the south, and Ziklag, and smitten Ziklag, and burned it with fire;

<sup>2</sup> And had taken the women captives, that *were* therein: they slew not any, either great or small, but carried *them* away, and went on their way.

<sup>3</sup> So David and his men came to the city, and, behold, *it was* burned with fire; and their wives, and their sons, and their daughters, were taken captives.

<sup>4</sup> Then David and the people that *were* with him lifted up their voice and wept, until they had no more power to weep.

<sup>5</sup> And David's two wives were taken captives, Ahinoam the Jezreelitess, and Abigail the wife of Nabal the Carmelite.

<sup>6</sup> And David was greatly distressed; for the people spake of stoning him, because the soul of all the people was grieved, every man for his sons and for his daughters: but David encouraged himself in the LORD his God.

### **Proverbs 14:12-13**

<sup>12</sup> There is a way which seemeth right unto a man, but the end thereof *are* the ways of death.

<sup>13</sup> Even in laughter the heart is sorrowful; and the end of that mirth *is* heaviness.



## Lesson 6 – God’s Forgiven Sinner – 2 Sam 11,12

### **2 Samuel 11,12**

#### **2 Samuel 23:34**

<sup>34</sup> Eliphelet the son of Ahasbai, the son of the Maachathite, Eliam the son of Ahithophel the Gilonite,

#### **2 Samuel 11:3**

<sup>3</sup> And David sent and enquired after the woman. And *one* said, *Is* not this Bathsheba, the daughter of Eliam, the wife of Uriah the Hittite?

#### **2 Samuel 15:12**

<sup>12</sup> And Absalom sent for Ahithophel the Gilonite, David's counsellor, from his city, *even* from Giloh, while he offered sacrifices. And the conspiracy was strong; for the people increased continually with Absalom.

#### **2 Samuel 16:20-17:4**

<sup>20</sup> Then said Absalom to Ahithophel, Give counsel among you what we shall do.

<sup>21</sup> And Ahithophel said unto Absalom, Go in unto thy father's concubines, which he hath left to keep the house; and all Israel shall hear that thou art abhorred of thy father: then shall the hands of all that *are* with thee be strong.

<sup>22</sup> So they spread Absalom a tent upon the top of the house; and Absalom went in unto his father's concubines in the sight of all Israel.

<sup>23</sup> And the counsel of Ahithophel, which he counselled in those days, *was* as if a man had enquired at the oracle of God: so *was* all the counsel of Ahithophel both with David and with Absalom.

<sup>1</sup> Moreover Ahithophel said unto Absalom, Let me now choose out twelve thousand men, and I will arise and pursue after David this night:

<sup>2</sup> And I will come upon him while he *is* weary and weak handed, and will make him afraid: and all the people that *are* with him shall flee; and I will smite the king only:

<sup>3</sup> And I will bring back all the people unto thee: the man whom thou seekest *is* as if all returned: so all the people shall be in peace.

<sup>4</sup> And the saying pleased Absalom well, and all the elders of Israel.

#### **Philippians 3:13**

<sup>13</sup> Brethren, I count not myself to have apprehended: but *this* one thing *I do*, forgetting those things which are behind, and reaching forth unto those things which are before,

### **1 Timothy 1:12-16**

<sup>12</sup> And I thank Christ Jesus our Lord, who hath enabled me, for that he counted me faithful, putting me into the ministry;

<sup>13</sup> Who was before a blasphemer, and a persecutor, and injurious: but I obtained mercy, because I did *it* ignorantly in unbelief.

<sup>14</sup> And the grace of our Lord was exceeding abundant with faith and love which is in Christ Jesus.

<sup>15</sup> This *is* a faithful saying, and worthy of all acceptation, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners; of whom I am chief.

<sup>16</sup> Howbeit for this cause I obtained mercy, that in me first Jesus Christ might shew forth all longsuffering, for a pattern to them which should hereafter believe on him to life everlasting.

<sup>12</sup> And they mourned, and wept, and fasted until even, for Saul, and for Jonathan his son, and for the people of the LORD, and for the house of Israel; because they were fallen by the sword.

<sup>15</sup> And David called one of the young men, and said, Go near, *and* fall upon him. And he smote him that he died.

<sup>16</sup> And David said unto him, Thy blood *be* upon thy head; for thy mouth hath testified against thee, saying, I have slain the LORD'S anointed.

### **2 Samuel 12:25**

<sup>25</sup> And he sent by the hand of Nathan the prophet; and he called his name Jedidiah, because of the LORD.

<sup>7</sup> And Nathan said to David, Thou *art* the man. Thus saith the LORD God of Israel, I anointed thee king over Israel, and I delivered thee out of the hand of Saul;

<sup>8</sup> And I gave thee thy master's house, and thy master's wives into thy bosom, and gave thee the house of Israel and of Judah; and if *that had been* too little, I would moreover have given unto thee such and such things.

<sup>9</sup> Wherefore hast thou despised the commandment of the LORD, to do evil in his sight? thou hast killed Uriah the Hittite with the sword, and hast taken his wife *to be* thy wife, and hast slain him with the sword of the children of Ammon.

### **2 Samuel 12:13-14**

<sup>13</sup> And David said unto Nathan, I have sinned against the LORD. And Nathan said unto David, The LORD also hath put away thy sin; thou shalt not die.

<sup>14</sup> Howbeit, because by this deed thou hast given great occasion to the enemies of the LORD to blaspheme, the child also *that is* born unto thee shall surely die.

### **2 Samuel 12:24-25**

<sup>24</sup> And David comforted Bathsheba his wife, and went in unto her, and lay with her: and she bare a son, and he called his name Solomon: and the LORD loved him.

<sup>25</sup> And he sent by the hand of Nathan the prophet; and he called his name Jedidiah, because of the LORD.

### **2 Samuel 12:5-6**

<sup>5</sup> And David's anger was greatly kindled against the man; and he said to Nathan, As the LORD liveth, the man that hath done this *thing* shall surely die:

<sup>6</sup> And he shall restore the lamb fourfold, because he did this thing, and because he had no pity.
